About the school

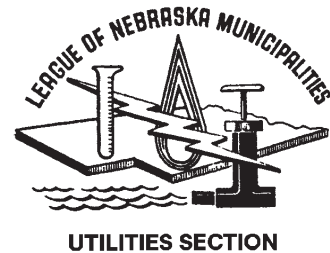
